

Military General Service Medal 1793-1814

Obverse	The diademed head of Queen Victoria and the legend 'VICTORIA REGINA' with the date 1848.
Reverse	Queen Victoria on a dias about to place a laurel wreath on the Duke of Wellington, who is kneeling on his left knee. Beside the dias is a diminutive representation of the British Lion dormant. Around the top half of the circumference is the inscription 'TO THE BRITISH ARMY'. In the exergue are the dates '1793-1814' although the first action commemorated by a bar is Egypt 1801, it can only be presumed that the authorities had in mind earlier actions, hence the date 1793, in the exergue.
