

### Khedive's Sudan Medal 1896 – 1908

- Obverse** An Arabic inscription which reads 'ABBAS HILMI THE SECOND' dated 1314AH (1897 AD).
- Reverse** An oval shield bearing three stars and crescents in the centre and surrounded by lances and flags. The whole is superimposed on two crossed rifles and cannons with a pyramid of six cannon balls. Beneath the whole is the Arabic inscription 'THE RECONQUEST OF THE SUDAN, 1314'.
- Size** 39mm
- Metal** Silver & Bronze
- Ribbon** 39mm wide. Yellow with a broad blue stripe down the centre symbolic of the Nile flowing through the desert.
- Bars issued** Fifteen, named in both English and Arabic.
